2. POSTER SIGN-OFF

An updated version of the club's promotional poster had been circulated by the Chair prior to the meeting for feedback. It was agreed to use the version with the graphical image rather than the photograph and make minor amendments to the times listed for training and the bullet point about free sessions. The poster was **approved** for use subject to these changes, which the Chair would make. A separate version of the poster would be created to advertise the exhibition match discussed under item 3.

3. EXHIBITION MATCH

First of all it was agreed to purchase anti-slip for the post bases in advance of the event, perhaps from a supplier at the marina. **ACTION: Treasurer**

The date for the proposed exhibition match at the Barony astro turf was suggested as Saturday 23rd April, 12-3pm. Club members would be invited to attend and an alternative date would be considered only in the event that there were insufficient numbers. The Development Officer, as a member of the SaCKA committee, would communicate the date to other clubs interested in the event, which could be run as a mini tournament.

4. REFEREE FEEDBACK TO SaCKA

The Committee discussed concerns regarding the performances of referees in recent matches.

There was a reluctance amongst some clubs in the local league to field a referee, which was a requirement for the club designated as the 'home team' for a match; also, requests for refereeing were often made at late notice. Perceptions of bias were raised as an issue and it was proposed to establish any concerns shortly after the match, should they require official reporting to area representatives along with the match form.

It was agreed to propose to the SaCKA committee that a message be sent to clubs reminding of the requirement to provide a referee for home matches.
