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NOTES ABOUT PLAYER REGISTRATION

This player registration form is used to register players are members of Crewe & Nantwich Korfball Club. Please hand completed forms to the Club Secretary. There is a separate form for under-18s.

Use of your data:

Completed forms are stored securely in an electronic format on the club's Gmail account with hard copies disposed of confidentially. Only members of the club's Executive Committee have access to the Gmail account.

What happens next?

New players are sent log-in details for 'Fixtures Live': an online system used for all korfball player registration and match details in England.

Registration on 'Fixtures Live' is required in order for you to be eligible to play in league fixtures under England Korfball Association (EKA) rules. Once you receive the registration email please follow the instructions to enter your details on Fixtures Live and upload a passport-style photograph for player verification.

What does membership mean?

Members have the following privileges:

- Participation in competitions such as SaCKa (Staffordshire & Cheshire Korfball Association) league and cup matches and summer tournaments
- Third party insurance for competitive matches
- Voting rights at the Club's Annual General Meeting (AGM), usually in June
- The right to stand for election to the Executive Committee

There is no membership fee, instead players pay per session. For the latest fee rates please speak to the Club Treasurer.
